May I wish everyone a successful and fruitful vacation filled with growth, learning and achievement. I wish and pray for a prosperous academic year 2023-24.

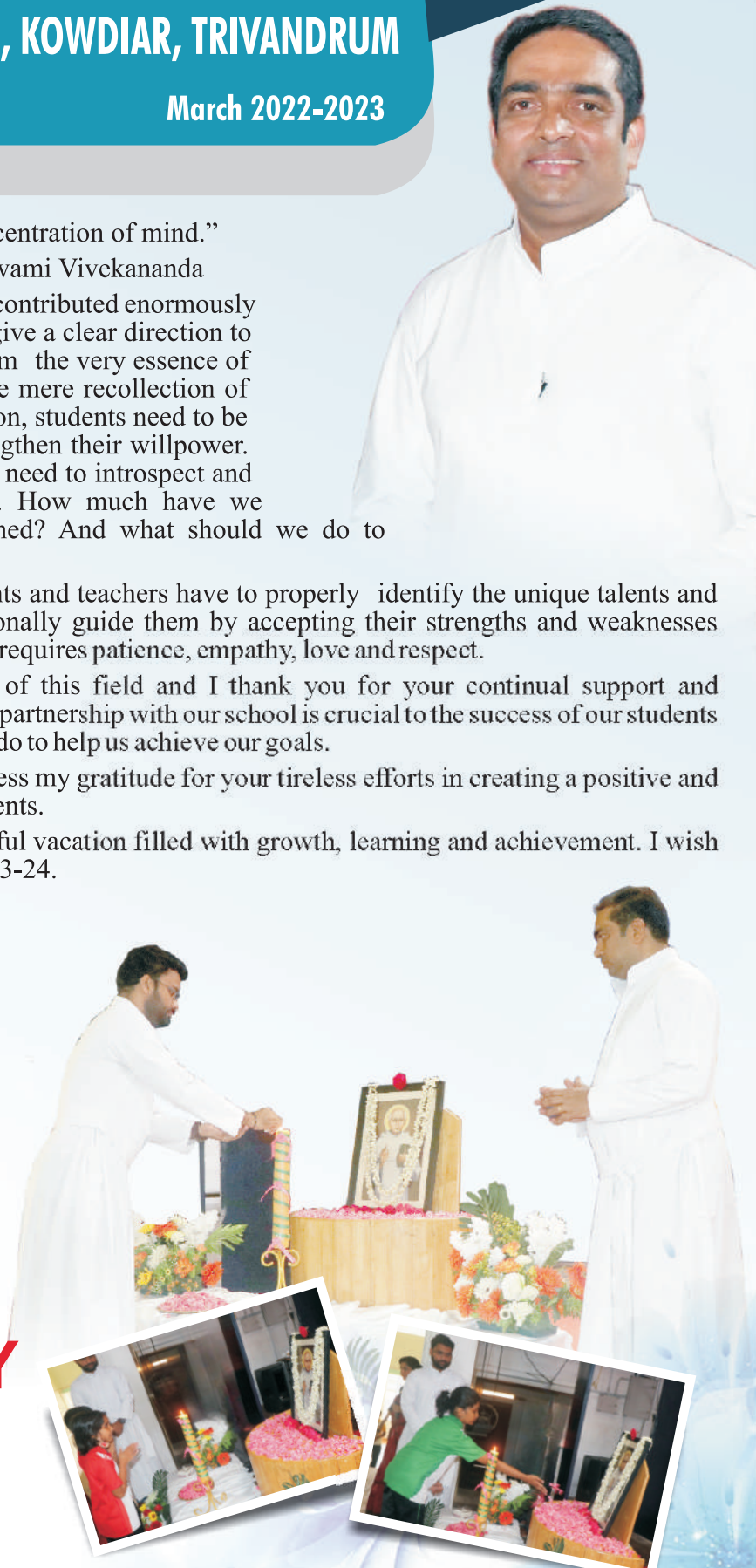
